

Sayyid Al-Hakeem urges to provide water and modern machinery to support Babylon's farmers



Sayyid Ammar Al-Hakeem, Head of the National State Powers Alliance, met with sheiks and dignitaries of Tufayl tribe from Al-Kifl district.
