

Sayyid Al-Hakeem Lauds Iraqi Components' Sacrifices to Fight Dictatorship Regime



During His Eminence's meeting with the delegation representing those with red cards—a group that faced oppression and injustice under the former regime for rejecting its wars and reckless policies—Sayyid Ammar Al-Hakeem, Head of the National State Powers' Alliance, called for the documentation of these crimes and for educating future generations about the experiences of this group and other segments of society.
