

Sayyid Al-Hakeem: Kirkuk Is a Miniature Iraq, Success There Reflects Success Nationwide



Sayyid Ammar Al-Hakeem, Head of the National State Powers Alliance, met with the Emir of the Al-Naim tribe, Sheikh Sufyan Al-Naimi, to discuss the latest political developments in the country, as well as the security and social situation in Kirkuk.
