Sayyid Al-Hakeem Stress General Amnesty Law Amendment to Halt Iraqi Blood Shed Involved Persons' Release



Sayyid Ammar Al-Hakeem, Head of the National State Powers' Alliance, Headed the regular meeting of the Advisory Body of Al-Hikma National Movement, and reviewed the agenda items and discussed developments in Iraqi and regional political affairs. His Eminence stressed the need to amend the General Amnesty Law to ensure that anyone involved in spilling Iraqi blood is not granted release, thereby reinforcing justice.

This solemn occasion coincides with significant events in the region and the anniversary of the martyrdom of the leaders of victory (May Allah have mercy on them).
