

Sayyid Al-Hakeem Visits Basra Oil and Gas University, Emphasizes Importance of Developing the Oil Sector and Utilizing Resources



As part of his tour in Basra, His Eminence Sayyid Ammar Al-Hakeem, Head of the National State Powers' Alliance, visited Basra University of Oil and Gas.
