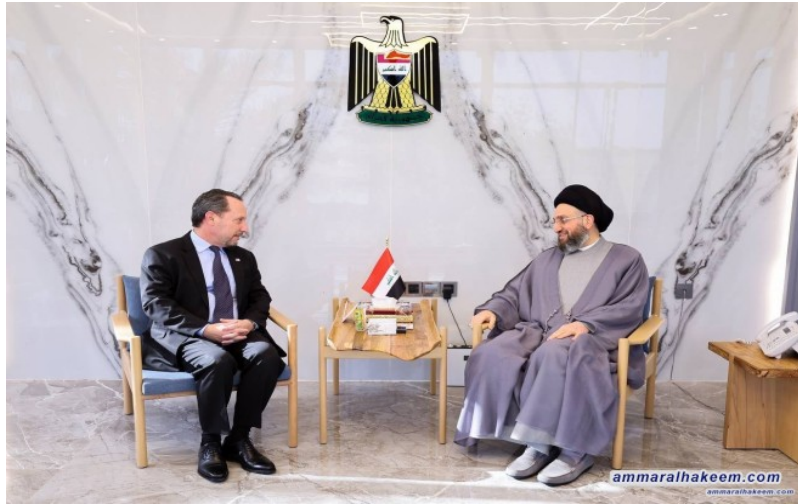


Sayyid Al-Hakeem Meets U.S. Embassy Chargé d'Affaires in Baghdad
