

Sayyid Al-Hakeem Receives Foreign Minister Fouad Hussein, Reviews Political Developments, Iraq's Regional Role



His Eminence Sayyid Al-Hakeem, Head of the National State Powers' Alliance, received the Deputy Prime Minister and Minister of Foreign Affairs Dr. Fouad Hussein at His office in Baghdad on Sunday evening. The meeting involved an exchange of views on developments in Iraq's political landscape, the efforts of the Iraqi Foreign Ministry to safeguard the country's interests, and Iraq's role in supporting regional stability.
