

Sayyid Al-Hakeem visits martyrs' families in Diwaniyah, praises sacrifice, calls for their justice



Sayyid Ammar Al-Hakeem, head of Al-Hikma National Movement, met with several martyrs' families in Diwaniyah 22-23/3/2022, including the family of the martyr Mohammed Shalaka, the family of the martyr Taher Al-Aaridhi, the martyr Zulfikar Al-Fatlawi, the late Sayyid Alaa Hamid Al-Awadi, the martyr Sayyid Jamal Nasser Al-Awadi, and the family of the martyr Kazim Falih Rikhis Abu Ebra praising the sacrifices made to defend Iraq in its various stages, the stage of confronting dictatorship, the stage of building the new Iraq, and confronting terrorism with its multiple addresses.
