Sayyid Al-Hakeem calls to draft Diwaniyah's budget according to deprivation percentage



The meeting of Sayyid Ammar Al-Hakeem, head of Al-Hikma National Movement, with the elites and competencies of Diwaniyah Province was the end of his tour in Diwaniyah on 23/3/2022, where H.E. listened to their valuable interventions and visions about the development of the province's reality and deliberated with them in the political and social public affairs.

His Eminence said that Diwaniyah is not a poor city and the evidence for this is the minds and competencies they possess, calling for fairness to them in the budget and looking at them from the perspective of deprivation and not depending on their population census.
