

Sayyid Al-Hakeem offers condolences over Ahl Al-Bayt's followers' death in Mazar-i-Sharif Afghanistan



Sayyid Ammar Al-Hakeem, head of Al-Hikma National Movement, expressed his condolences over the fall of several citizens from the followers of Ahl Al-Bayt in Afghanistan in the Mazar-i-Sharif district on 29/4/2022.
