

Sayyid Al-Hakeem calls to achieve food security, respect judicial decisions



In the guest place of Hajj Sheik Shihab Abu Saiba', the sheik of the Abu Saiba' clan in Najaf Al-Ashraf province, Sayyid Ammar Al-Hakeem, head of Al-Hikma National Movement, met with a genuine group of sheiks and dignitaries in the city of Najaf Al-Ashraf 1/6/2022, recalling the history of the city in Iraq's major stations, indicating the role of the Religious Reference is one of the most important pillars of society and the preservation of the Islamic identity in it.
