

Sayyid Al-Hakeem: National majority is possible through the winning lists or with the participation of those wishing to participate



In the generous guest-place of Sheik Raheem Mijaiser Al-Baydani in Jameela area of Baghdad and the presence of a large group of sheiks and dignitaries of the Iraqi clans on 12/6/2022, Sayyid Ammar Al-Hakeem, head of Al-Hikma National Movement, blessed the honorable attendees with the birth of Imam Ali bin Musa Al-Ridha "PBUH" and exchanged views on the developments of the political scene in Iraq and the outcomes of government formation and ways out of the political impasse in the country.
