

Sayyid Al-Hakeem calls international community to protect Afghani people from terrorist operations



Sayyid Ammar Al-Hakeem, head of Al-Hikma National Movement, received an Afghan delegation of political and social leaders, led by Sheikh Mohammed Muhaqiq, the head of the Afghan Umma Party, and exchanged condolences on Ziyarat Arba'een of Imam Hussein "Peace Be Upon Him" and the anniversary of the death of the Noble Prophet Mohammed "peace and blessings of Allah be upon him and his family".
