
Sayyid Al-Hakeem to Basra Governor: Basra's Success is Iraq's Success, petrodollar as minimum compensation to be granted to it



Sayyid Ammar Al-Hakeem, Head of Al-Hikma National Movement, in his office in Baghdad, met the Governor of Basra, Asad Al-Aidani, and discussed with him the city's concerns and rights and the sustainability of construction and preparation for the Gulf Championship 25 on Friday, 4/11/2022.
