Sayyid Al-Hakeem calls for serious action to bridge the citizens and the political system gap



At the First Conference of the Second Session of the General Assembly of Al-Hikma National Movement on 12/11/2022, Sayyid Ammar Al-Hakeem, Head of Al-Hikma National Movement, illustrated the developments in the political and movement scenes, the nature of the changes in the previous phase and the role of Al-Hikma movement in dismantling the state of political impasse, noting the nature of the position of the Movement to not participate in the government, yet support it and work on making it a success.
