

Sayyid Al-Hakeem renews support to Al-Sudani's Government to establish Disadvantaged Areas' Support Fund



Sayyid Ammar Al-Hakeem, head of the Al-Hikma National Movement, met with a group of elites and competencies of Al-Muthanna Province on 22/12/2022.
