## Sayyid Al-Hakeem calls to reconsider central admission to match labor market's needs



Sayyid Ammar Al-Hakeem, head of Al-Hikma National Movement, received the Minister of Higher Education and Scientific Research, His Excellency Dr. Naeem Al-Aboodi on 28/12/2022, and called to reconsider the central admission system for institutes and colleges, in collaboration with the Ministry of Planning, for it to be coherent with the market's demands. H.E. illustrated that an educated Iraqi citizen that believes in a new Iraq and its democratic system is one of the main reasons for higher education. This can be achieved through curricula that support it, and education faculties that possess considerable abilities and believe in the democratic system in Iraq.

His Eminence reiterated the importance of internal monitoring to curb targeting the new Iraq.
