Sayyid Al-Hakeem partake in the memorial service for The Victory Leaders



During the memorial service held by the Embassy of the Islamic Republic of Iran to Baghdad on the anniversary of the martyrdom of the Victory Leaders "May Allah's mercy be upon them" on 31/12/2022, Sayyid Ammar Al-Hakeem, head of Al-Hikma National Movement, affirmed that speaking of martyrs and their national, ideological, and heroic value to their peoples and communities is a very complex and difficult task, with which words are unable to describe the sacrifice to which the martyr have made in defense of his religion, his people, his land, and his homeland.
