

Sayyid Al-Hakeem stresses Islamic communities' diversity management, calls to invent new unity-strengthening means



Sayyid Ammar Al-Hakeem, head of Al-Hikma National Movement, met a delegation from Pakistan, which consisted of religious scholars and academics from different sects and components Wednesday, 8/2/2023, and indicated Iraq's historical reading, as it is a starting point and an end for history and the axel that connects them. His Eminence illustrated that Iraq became a station for the Muslims of the world due to its historical and Islamic status.
