

Sayyid Al-Hakeem, calls to include private sector internet providers to compete



Sayyid Ammar Al-Hakeem, head of Al-Hikma National Movement, met with the Minister of Communications, Mrs. Hiyam Al-Yasiree on 10/4/2023, and thanked Her Excellency for her condolences over the death of the scholar Sayyid Sadiq Al-Hakeem "May Allah have mercy on him".
