

Sayyid Al-Hakeem calls to use diversity to build strong prosperous Iraq



In the guest place of the blessed Beirkhudri Radhwi Sayyids, Sayyid Ammar Al-Hakeem, head of Al-Hikma National Movement, met a group of Kurd brothers in the governorate of As Sulaymaniyah on 12/5/2023, recalling the common history they share. His Eminence stated that recalling these historical events to take lessons from them, stating that nations that forget their history are weak.
