Sayyid Al-Hakeem receives Turkish Foreign Minister, calls to transform Baghdad-Ankara relationship to political & economic partnership, hope Turkey increase water release



Sayyid Ammar Al-Hakeem, head of Al-Hikma National Movement, received the Turkish Foreign Minister, Mr. Hakan Fidan on 23/8/2023, and illustrated that his visit represents an important message to deepen the relationship between Iraq and Turkey.
