

Sayyid Al-Hakeem emphasizes differences management to ensure everyone's interests



Sayyid Ammar Al-Hakeem, Head of Al-Hikma National Movement, met with Sheikh Sabah Al-Kheilani, on 9/10/2023, reminiscing about the enduring journey they shared in confronting dictatorship and combating terrorism.
