

Sayyid Al-Hakeem lauds Al-Hikma's sons upcoming elections' preparations, urges doubling efforts till elections' day



In a gathering of elites and competencies of Al-Hikma National Movement, Sayyid Ammar Al-Hakeem, Head of Al-Hikma National Movement, lauded the high motivation and readiness displayed for the impending elections. His Eminence underscored the imperative of redoubling efforts in the remaining period.
