

Sayyid Al-Hakeem breaks fast with Muaskar Al-Rasheed's Engineers, Workers, lauds foreign, Arabic companies presence



Sayyid Ammar Al-Hakeem, Head of Al-Hikma National Movement, met with engineers and workers at the construction site of Al-Zafaraniyah / Rashid Camp Bridge and Tunnel, congratulating them on the blessed month of Ramadan.
