

Sayyid Al-Hakeem: Iraq experiences politically, socially, security-wise stability, admired by others



In the district of Al-Khidr in the Muthanna Governorate, Sayyid Ammar Al-Hakeem, Head of Al-Hikma National Movement, met with a group of sheiks and dignitaries at the residence of Sheikh Al-Hajj Jubair Saleh Mazboob Al-Tai, reminiscing about the impact of the Shaaban uprising on the Iraqi people.
