Sayyid Al-Hakeem: Iraq, through the eyes of others, appears different from the perspective of Iraqis immersed in daily details



Among Al Abes tribe, known as the tribe of martyrs, and in the guest place of Sheikh Saud Akaz Al Bu Majid, Sayyid Ammar Al-Hakeem, Head of Al-Hikma National Movement, expressed his deep appreciation for the positions defending religion and sanctities of the honorable Al-Abs tribe.
