

Sayyid Al-Hakeem lauds Palestinian patients' spirits, holds international community, Islamic world responsible to defend the Palestinian cause



During His Eminence visit to the wounded Palestinians at the Medical City Hospital in Baghdad, Sayyid Ammar Al-Hakeem, head of Al-Hikma National Movement, lauded the high spirits of the wounded men, women, and children we met were remarkable, as they expressed their hope to return to their country victorious and with their heads held high, God willing.
