Sayyid Al-Hakeem calls on organizational leaders in Diwaniyah to work for the service of the people of Diwaniyah



At the conclusion of his tour in the beloved province of Diwaniyah, Sayyid Ammar Al-Hakeem, Head of Al-Hikma National Movement, met with a large gathering of organizational leaders in the province.
