Sayyid Al-Hakeem: Parliament's budget schedules' approval without amendments shows confidence in government's plans



At the guesthouse of the Gureit tribe, hosted by Sheikh Zohair Kazem Al-Merhoun, the chief of the Gureit tribes, Sayyid Ammar Al-Hakeem, Head of Al-Hikma National Movement, met with several sheiks and dignitaries. H.E. praised the level of reconstruction and development in the holy province of Karbala, noting that the Parliament's approval of the budget schedules without any amendments is a sign of confidence in the government's direction and plans.
