

Sayyid Al-Hakeem Praises Holy Karbala Reconstruction and Development



In Al-Husseiniya district of Karbala, His Eminence met with the noble Al-Masoud tribe at the guesthouse of Sheikh Sabah Nouri Al-Samramad, the tribal chief, along with several of its sheiks and dignitaries.
