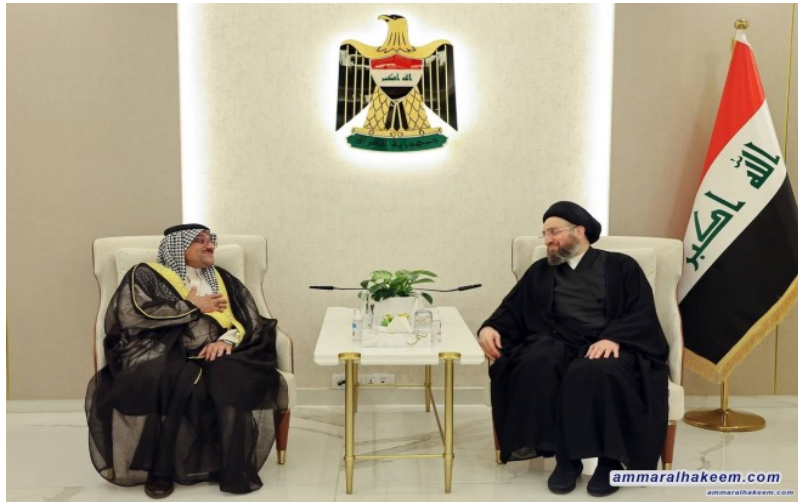


Sayyid Al-Hakeem discusses Diyala province state, its reconstruction, development projects with Bani Tameem tribal sheiks
