

Sayyid Al-Hakeem Calls to Implement Women's Conference Outcomes, to Distinguish Between Legislative and Executive Duties



Following the Islamic Day Conference for Combating Violence Against Women, Sayyid Ammar Al-Hakeem, Head of the National State Powers' Alliance, met with several representatives of Iraq's diverse communities. His Eminence praised the role of women in Iraqi society and their determination to secure their legal and religious rights.

H.E. emphasized the importance of following up on the outcomes and recommendations of women-related conferences, urging that these be clearly categorized into legislative and executive responsibilities.
