

Sayyid Al-Hakeem calls to integrate religious institutions with Christian and other endowment offices



Sayyid Ammar Al-Hakeem, Head of the National State Powers Alliance, met with Dr. Rami Joseph Agajan, Head of the Christian, Yazidi, and Sabeen Mandaean Endowment Office, and emphasized the importance of preserving and empowering Iraq's diverse communities, particularly those affected by terrorism and sectarian or ethnic violence. His Eminence stressed that the presence of these communities in Iraq's national landscape should be valued for their qualitative contributions rather than their numbers.
