

Sayyid Al-Hakeem Calls to Grant Local Governments Constitutional, Legal Powers



Sayyid Ammar Al-Hakeem, Head of the National State Powers Alliance, met with members of the National State Powers' Alliance bloc in local governments and listened to their insights.
