

Sayyid Al-Hakeem Meets with Yemeni Religious Scholar, Sayyid Mohammed Abdul-Azim Al-Houthi



Sayyid Ammar Al-Hakeem, Head of the National State Powers Alliance, met with Sayyid Mohammed Abdul-Azim Al-Houthi, a prominent religious scholar from Yemen.
