Sayyid Al-Hakeem: Iraqis Share Defining Moments to Face Oppression, Build the State, Fight Terrorism



During a gathering at the guesthouse of Sheikh Najm Agha and Sheikh Jawhar Agha Al-Surji, Sayyid Ammar Al-Hakeem, Head of the National State Powers Alliance, met with sheikhs and dignitaries from the Surji tribe.
