Sayyid Al-Hakeem Praises Imam Ali (PBUH) Brigade role to Ensure Al-Najaf Al-Ashraf's Security, Despite Public's Lack of Awareness Due to Its Deployment Locations



At the beginning of the second day of his visit to Al-Najaf Al-Ashraf, Sayyid Ammar Al-Hakeem, Head of the National State Powers Alliance, met with the officers, ranks, and personnel of Imam Ali (PBUH) Combat Brigade.
