

Sayyid Al-Hakeem: The School of Moderation and Balance is a Source of Pride for All Iraqis



During his meeting with the organizational leaders of Al-Hikma Movement in Wasit Province, Sayyid Ammar Al-Hakeem, Head of Al-Hikma National Movement, stated, "Wasit occupies a special place in the hearts of Iraqis, as it is centrally located within Iraq itself.
