
Sayyid Al-Hakeem Visits Iraq Stars League Headquarters, Emphasizes Support for Iraqi Football



Head of the National State Powers Alliance, Sayyid Ammar Al-Hakeem, visited the Iraq Stars League headquarters in Baghdad, where His Eminence met with the President of the Iraqi Football Association, Captain Adnan Dirjal. In addition, H.E. underscored the importance of unity in sports media, urging stakeholders to avoid divisive rhetoric or actions. H.E. described sports as a bridge that fosters connections between nations.

H.E. further stressed the importance of investing in youth development within clubs, identifying and nurturing talent through sports academies and grassroots teams. H.E. stated that creating a supportive environment is essential to cultivating future stars.

Concluding the visit, H.E. noted that this engagement aimed to assess the national team's status following its Gulf Cup participation and understand the reasons behind its shortcomings. H.E. reaffirmed that continuous support for the national team is a vital component of efforts

to elevate the level of Iraqi sports.
