Sayyid Al-Hakeem Calls for Budget Amendment to Facilitate Iraqi Oil Exports, Boost National Revenue



Sayyid Ammar Al-Hakeem, head of the National State Powers Alliance, called for voting on an amendment to the budget that would facilitate the export of Iraqi oil and utilize its revenues to enhance the country's financial resources. His Eminence emphasized the urgent need for Iraq to diversify its revenue streams to meet citizens' needs.
