

Sayyid Al-Hakeem Emphasizes Local Governments Role Toward Stability, Development



As part of his visit to Dhi Qar, Sayyid Ammar Al-Hakeem, Head of the National State Powers' Alliance, met with Governor Murtada Al-Ibrahimi, his deputies, several provincial council members, administrative unit heads, service department directors, and security leaders.
