

Sayyid Al-Hakeem from North Basra: Emphasizes Transforming Stability to Lasting Stability, Redress Marginalized Areas



During His Eminence's visit to Al-Madina district in North Basra, at the guesthouse of Sheikh Hassan Al-Ruwaimi, Sayyid Ammar Al-Hakeem, Head of the National State Powers' Alliance, commemorated the blessed birth anniversary of Imam Al-Mahdi (May Allah hasten his reappearance) and the Shaaban Uprising.
