

Sayyid Al-Hakeem Discusses Iraqi, Regional Political Developments with Adil Abdul-Mahdi, Emphasizes Stability, Upcoming Elections



Sayyid Ammar Al-Hakeem, Head of the National State Powers' Alliance, met with former Prime Minister Dr. Adil Abdul-Mahdi to review the evolving political landscape in Iraq and the broader region, along with the upcoming national obligations.
