

Sayyid Al-Hakeem Calls to Support Young Talents, Expand Opportunities for Higher Education, Employment



In commemoration of the sorrowful anniversary of the martyrdom of Imam Mohammed ibn Ali Al-Jawad (peace be upon him), a day that highlights the Imam's enduring legacy of patience, wisdom, and knowledge, Sayyid Ammar Al-Hakeem, Head of the National State Powers' Alliance, emphasized the importance of following the example of the Imams (peace be upon them) in nurturing and empowering young and scholarly talents.

This came during H.E.'s meeting with a delegation of students from the Department of Oil and Gas Economics at the College of Administrative and Financial Sciences, Imam Al-Sadiq University (peace be upon him), where H.E. listened to their concerns and aspirations.
