

Sayyid Al-Hakeem Stresses Al-Najaf Al-Ashraf's Significance, Urges Local Governments Empowerment



Sayyid Ammar Al-Hakeem, Head of the National State Powers Alliance, met with the Governor of Al-Najaf Al-Ashraf, Engineer Youssef Maki Gannawi, to discuss the city's current and future development and service projects.
