
Sayyid Al-Hakeem: Time to Cement Regional Stability, Prevent relapse into conflict



Sayyid Ammar Al-Hakeem, Head of the National State Powers Alliance, received the Chargé d'Affaires of the United States Embassy in Baghdad, Ambassador Steven Fagin, earlier today.

During the meeting, His Eminence emphasized that Iraq is currently experiencing an unprecedented period of peaceful coexistence and social solidarity, as clearly reflected during the early days of Muharram.
