Sayyid Al-Hakeem Meets Muthanna Tribal Sheiks, Dignitaries: Urges Responsible Electoral Participation, Stresses Moderation Path



Sayyid Ammar Al-Hakeem, Head of the National State Powers' Alliance, met on Saturday, September 27, 2025, with a gathering of sheikhs and dignitaries from Al-Muthanna Province. After listening to their remarks, His Eminence noted that the struggle between truth and falsehood often tilts materially in favor of falsehood, yet the people of truth prevail through steadfastness, sincerity, faith, and submission to Allah and His Messenger. H.E. emphasized that history is full of examples of the trials and challenges faced by the cause of truth.

Reiterating the call for broad, effective, and informed participation in the upcoming elections, H.E. highlighted their pivotal role in moving Iraq from fragile stability to lasting stability. H.E. further noted that Iraq has engaged with regional issues politically, in the media, and through humanitarian assistance, without being drawn into direct involvement, stressing the shared responsibility of all to preserve the achievements that have been made.
