

Sayyid Al-Hakeem Receives Foreign Minister Fuad Hussein, Describes Elections as Opportunity for Sustainable Stability, Highlights Diplomacy's Role in Reflecting Iraq's Positive Image



Sayyid Ammar Al-Hakeem, Head of the National State Powers Alliance, received on Monday evening, October 6, 2025, at his office in Baghdad, H.E. Dr. Fuad Hussein, Deputy Prime Minister and Minister of Foreign Affairs.

The meeting included an exchange of views on the latest political developments in Iraq and the region, upcoming national entitlements, and the role of Iraqi diplomacy in strengthening stability and promoting Iraq's positive image abroad.
