## Sayyid Al-Hakeem: Iraq's Services Success Is Achievable, as Proven in Security and Politics — Empowering Moderation Safeguards State



Sayyid Al-Hakeem, Head of the National State Powers' Alliance, met Sunday evening, October 13, 2025, with a group of Al-Mahdiyya Al-Musewi Sayyids, led by Sayyid Sahib Al-Mahdawi.
